Teach-It - What's it all about? - 20 minutes

Explore-It - Technology in Theory - 30 minutes

- Explore a wide variety of the key tools used to enhance learning/teaching in the 21st Century.
- Each tool will be given an introduction with brief examples of their use in the classroom.

Use-It - Technology in Action - 30 minutes

- A highly-interactive session providing opportunities to use a variety of technologies.
- Delegates will be encouraged to use the technology in a learning capacity.
- Delegates will examine games-based learning, experimental videos and podcasts and explore the web for educational tools.

Create-It - Lesson Plan Creation - 60 minutes

- Delegates will have the opportunity to start to link the Teach-It lesson ideas to the National Curriculum and, time permitting, create their own lesson ideas based around the technologies examined during the course.
